

It's Time to Freeze-Proof Your Pipes and Water Meter

Autumn in our state is simply beautiful and it's also the perfect time to make sure cold weather doesn't sneak into hidden corners of your home and freeze your pipes or meter, potentially causing costly water damage.

Start by checking any pipes that run through exterior walls. These are especially vulnerable to freezing if they lack proper insulation or are enclosed behind a cabinet.

If you have an outdoor water meter, ensure it's securely covered and protected from the cold.

If your pipes do freeze, never attempt to thaw them with an open flame. You could easily start a fire. Stay safe and call a licensed plumber instead.
