## The Invisible Dangers of Reservoir Ice



Frozen reservoirs may look beautiful, but stepping onto one is the last thing anyone should do — because it could lead to a life-threatening situation. Or, if they're lucky, it might only get them fined.

Reservoir water levels can fluctuate by the day and even hour. When levels drop in a frozen reservoir, gaps can form under the ice, greatly weakening it. Currents and upwellings can also eat away at the ice from below.

Every year, people fall through the ice of frozen reservoirs, and only some emerge

unhurt. That's why trespassing on an Aquarion reservoir can get you arrested and fined for trespassing.
