A Quick Guide to Your Billing Statement

Aguarion's billing statements offer valuable information to help you manage your finances, conserve water, and save time and money.

On the upper left, you'll see a graph showing your water usage over the past 13 months. Below the graph is a comparison of your current usage with the same period last year. Notice any big spikes? They could indicate a possible leak or water waste.

Just to the right, you'll find an information block with helpful information on a variety of topics.

On the upper right is a quick summary of your balance and due date. Flip your bill over for a detailed report of your Aquarion account, including meter readings, payments, recent charges, and more.

Keep the top portion of your bill for your records and use the detachable stub when mailing payments.
