

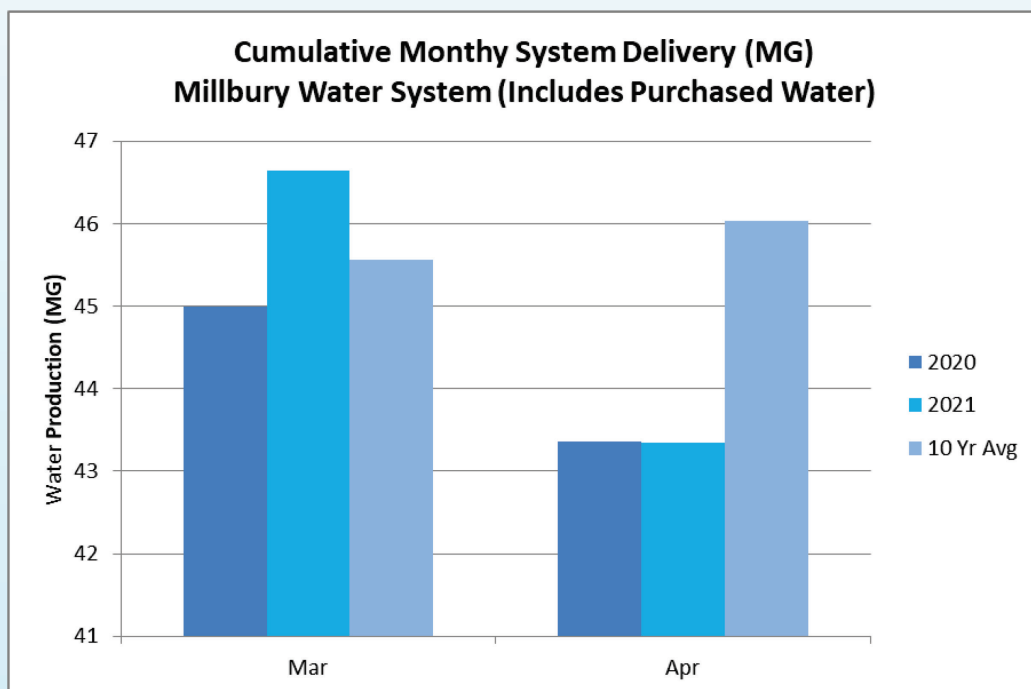
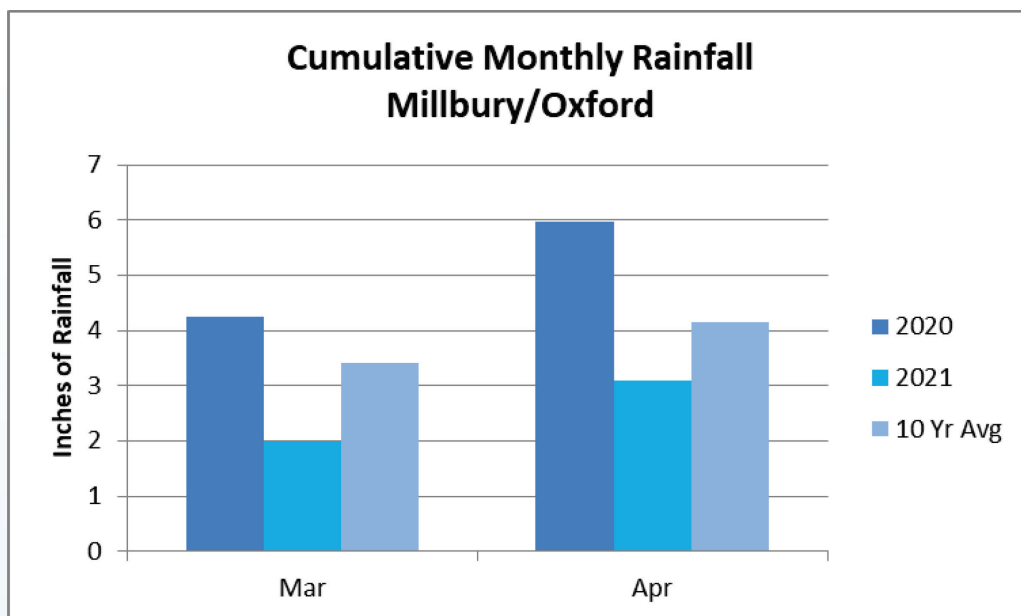


Water Supply Update

Serving the Community of Millbury

Weather Trends

Precipitation for March was 1.99 inches, which is 1.43 inches below the 10-year average precipitation for the month of March. April was 1.06 inches below average at 3.09 inches.



Water Supply and Demand

Water demands for March were above average for the month. April's demands were consistent with April 2020 demands. The average amount of water delivered to our system to meet demands in March was 1.50 million gallons per day (MGD) and 1.44 MGD in April.



Recent and Upcoming Water Main Upgrades

Aquarion crews have been busy upgrading water mains serving local customers. It's all part of our ongoing program of distribution system improvements needed to reduce water main breaks that can interrupt service.

Though this work can briefly disrupt water service, such as when we make connections to individual customers, in the long run the disruption (and the investment) is well worth it due to the improved service and reliability that result. Projects include:

- **Elmwood Street** – Paving was completed April 2021.
- **Captain Peter Simpson Road and Aldrich Avenue** The installation of water main and services will be completed by May 14. Three new fire hydrants were installed – two on Captain Peter Simpson Road and one on Aldrich Avenue.



Oak Pond Well PFAS Pilot Study

A pilot study test was conducted at the Oak Pond well to help in the design of a treatment plant. Aquarion has been chosen to receive SRF funding to construct a treatment plant at the well site. This project will be completed in 2023.
