

## Water Supply Update

Serving the Community of Oxford

#### **Weather Trends**

Precipitation for January was 2.27 inches, which is 1.24 inches below the 10-year average precipitation for the month of January. February was also slightly below average at 3.17 inches.





### **Water Supply and Demand**

Water demands through the month of January were normal for this time of year. February was approximately 8% above the 10-year average. The average amount of water delivered to our system to meet demands in January was 557,000 gallons per day (GPD) and 624,000 GPD in February.

#### **Recent and Upcoming Water Main Upgrades**

Oxford's water mains may be out of sight but they're never out of Aquarion's mind. To maintain water quality and reduce service disruptions caused by broken water mains, we have an ongoing program of distribution system improvements.

The most frequent work involves flushing mains to remove sediments that can cause discolored water. The most visible work takes place when we replace old or damaged mains, often in concert with local road improvement projects. Here's the update on recent projects in Oxford:

- Prospect Hill Tank Rehab To maintain our high standards of water quality and service, we've scheduled a rehabilitation project for the Prospect Hill tank. Construction bids are due in February 2021 and work is scheduled to begin this spring.
- **Church Street** This coming spring we'll be replacing 1000 feet of water main running from Forest Street to the end of Church Street. As always, we'll work closely with the Town to minimize traffic impacts and service disruptions. Bids are due in Feb 2021 with construction starting in early spring.
