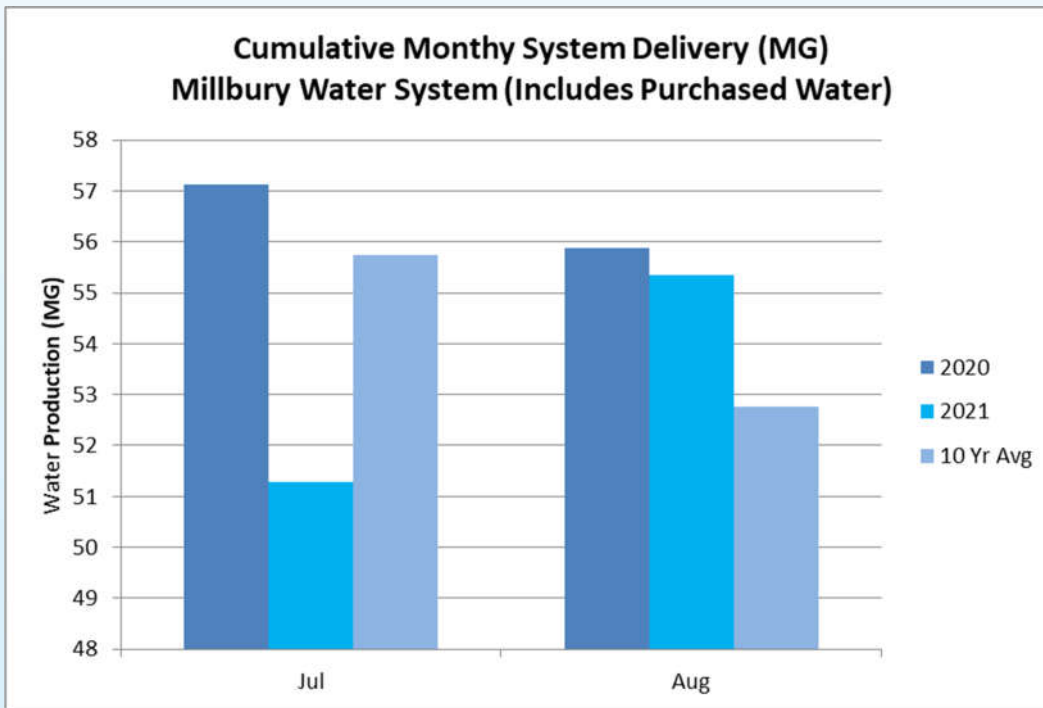
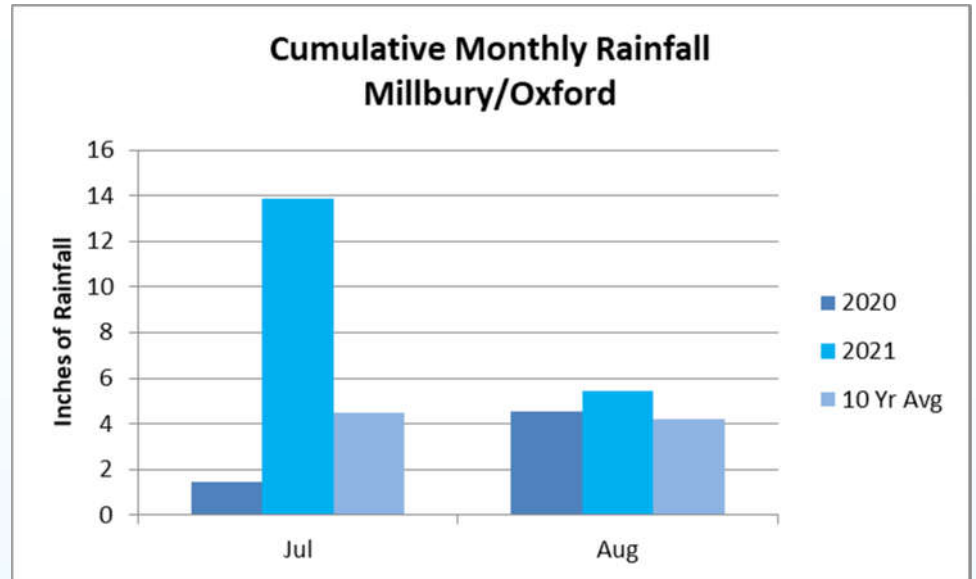


Water Supply Update

Serving the Community of Millbury

Weather Trends

Precipitation for July was 13.85 inches, which is 9.36 inches above the 10-year average precipitation for the month of July. August's 5.42 inches of precipitation was also above average by 1.24 inches.



Water Supply and Demand

Water demand in July was 11% lower than 2020 because of reduced outdoor water usage due all the rainfall. The average amount of water delivered to our system to meet demands in July was 1.65 million gallons per day (MGD) and 1.79 MGD in August.

Recent and Upcoming Water Main Upgrades

Aquarion crews have been busy upgrading water mains serving local customers. It's all part of our ongoing program of distribution system improvements needed to reduce water main breaks that can interrupt service. Projects include:

- **Parkhill Avenue** - 1,000 feet of 8" water main has been completed, in addition to two new fire hydrants and ten new services.
- **Captain Peter Simpson Road and Aldrich Avenue** - The installation of water main and services were completed at the end of May. The Town of Millbury will be paving in the Spring of 2022.



Oak Pond Well PFAS Pilot Study

The Oak Pond Well design for the treatment Plant is 100% completed. SRF funding has been approved to construct a treatment plant at the well site which will be completed in 2023.
