

Water Supply Update

Weather Trends

Precipitation for July was 13.85 inches, which is 9.36 inches above the 10-year average precipitation for the month of July. August's 5.42 inches of precipitation was also above average by 1.24 inches.





Water Supply and Demand

Water demand in July was 19% lower than 2020 due to reduced outdoor water usage. The average amount of water delivered to our system to meet demand in July was 698,612 gallons per day (GPD) and 832,806 GPD in August.

Recent and Upcoming Water Main Upgrades

Oxford's water mains may be out of sight but they're never out of Aquarion's mind. To maintain water quality and reduce service disruptions caused by broken water mains, we have an ongoing program of distribution system improvements.

The most frequent work involves flushing mains to remove sediment that can cause discolored water. The most visible work takes place when we replace old or damaged mains, often in concert with local road improvement projects. Here's an update on recent projects in Oxford:

- Prospect Hill Tank Rehab To maintain our high standard of water quality and service, we've scheduled a rehabilitation project for the Prospect Hill tank. Work continues and painting will start the third week of July and will last 10 to 12 weeks.
- Church Street Water Main Replacement This project was completed on June 21^t. Paving will be in the Spring of 2022.
- Oxford Water Main Cleaning Cleaning was completed the first week of June.
