
Water Supply Update

Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 2.86 inches in November. This amount was less than the long-term average of 3.8 inches. This is slightly consistent with the data from the last twelve months as Millbury/Oxford has had a little less precipitation than the average year. Millbury and Oxford are currently at Drought Level 3 – Extreme Drought.
