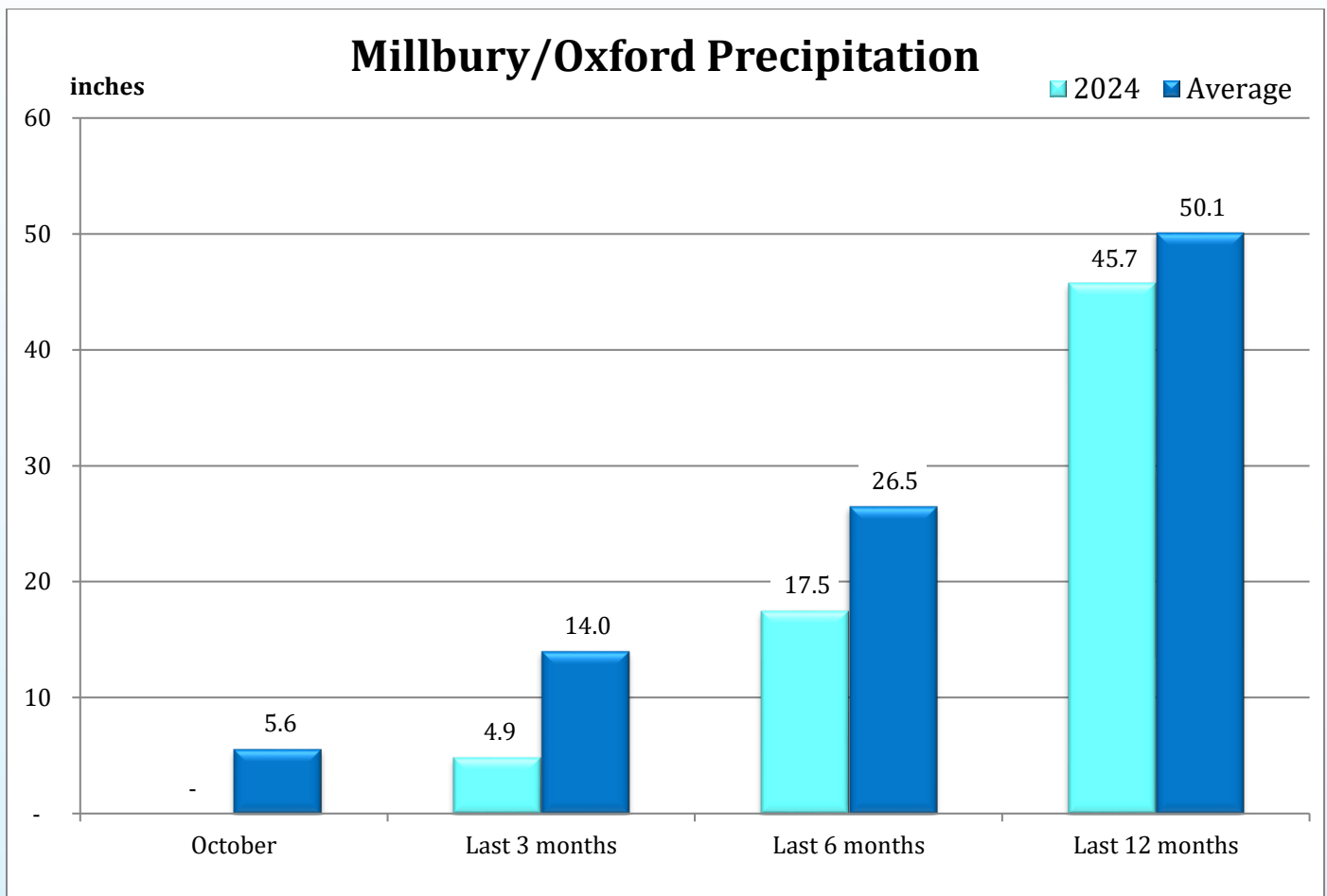


Water Supply Update

Serving the Communities of Millbury and Oxford

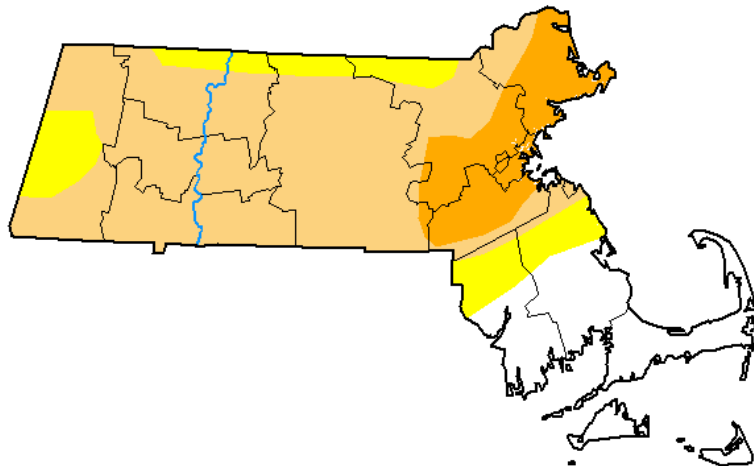
Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 0.00 inches in October. This amount was significantly less than the long-term average of 5.6 inches. This is slightly inconsistent with the data from the last twelve months as Millbury/Oxford has seen almost the same amount of precipitation for an average year in this region. Millbury and Oxford are currently at Drought Level 1 – Moderate Drought.
