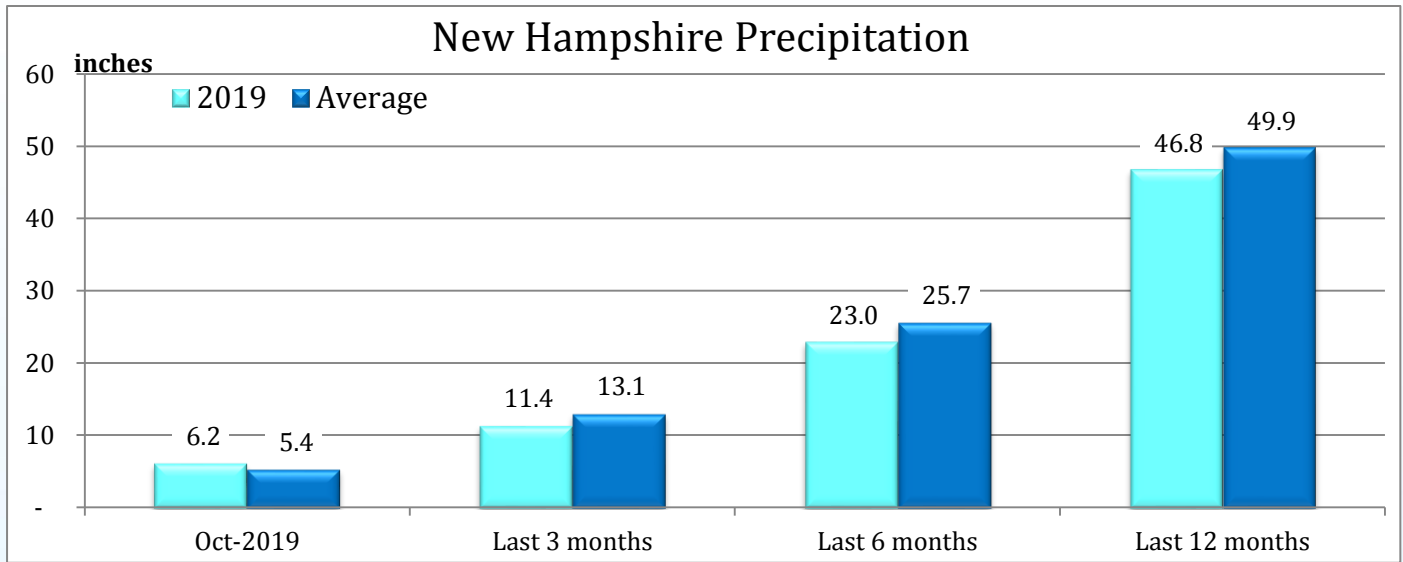


Water Supply Update

Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation in October totaled 6.2 inches compared to the long term average of 5.4 inches. Over the past 12 months, total precipitation is 3.1 inches below average. Average monthly temperature was 53°F, which is 3°F above the historical average.
