

Weather Trends/Outlook


Precipitation totaled 5.1 inches in December; more than the long-term average of 4.5 inches. Lower than average precipitation levels persist over the last year. The U.S. Drought Monitor map continues to show Abnormally Dry conditions over parts of the New Hampshire seacoast.
