Abenaki, an Aquarion Water Company, has applied for funds through the State of New Hampshire Drinking Water and Groundwater Trust Fund (DWGTF) to finance a water infrastructure improvements project in Carroll, NH.

This project includes constructing a new treatment/booster pump station facility and associated water main and site work at the Rosebrook Wellfield Site. The new building will house booster pumps, clearwell tanks, and chemical storage and feed systems. The existing building will be maintained for housing Well #1 and storage. Approximately 100 feet of 6-inch ductile iron water main will be constructed to and from the existing building to the new facility. The proposed piping will tie into existing piping within the building. Portions of the existing piping within the facility will be replaced. The area of disturbance is approximately 25,900 square feet. The gravel access drive will be expanded to add a turnaround area necessary of chemical deliveries and access to the new facility. The area of the additional gravel access drive is approximately 7,365 square feet. All required permits and approvals will be obtained prior to construction.

Whereas this project constitutes only a minor project, and no significant environmental impacts are anticipated, a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) is proposed.
