

# ANDERSON RD AND WEST BROTHER DR WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT UPDATE – AUGUST 2, 2021

### **General Project Information:**

The proposed project will include the installation of a new 16" water main, fire hydrants and water service connections on Anderson Road and West Brother Drive in Greenwich, from Woodside Drive to Mallard Drive. This project is part of Aquarion's ongoing initiative to improve the delivery of safe and reliable drinking water to our customers. The upgrades will also help to reduce leaks and water main breaks that can cause service interruptions. Due to construction, customers should expect minor traffic delays and possible detours during the working hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The general contractor performing this work is M. Rondano, Inc of Norwalk, CT.

To keep customers informed about scheduled/unscheduled work, Aquarion utilizes an Everbridge notification system to call affected customers. #### **Work Being Performed This Week:**

- Fill, chlorinate and flush the newly installed water main
- Take a bacteriological water sample
- Pressure test the newly installed water main
- Fill and chlorinate the second section of water main

### **Work Planned for the Next Two Weeks:**

- Test Pits to locate Utilities
- Once the water main has been activated, start on water service transfers
