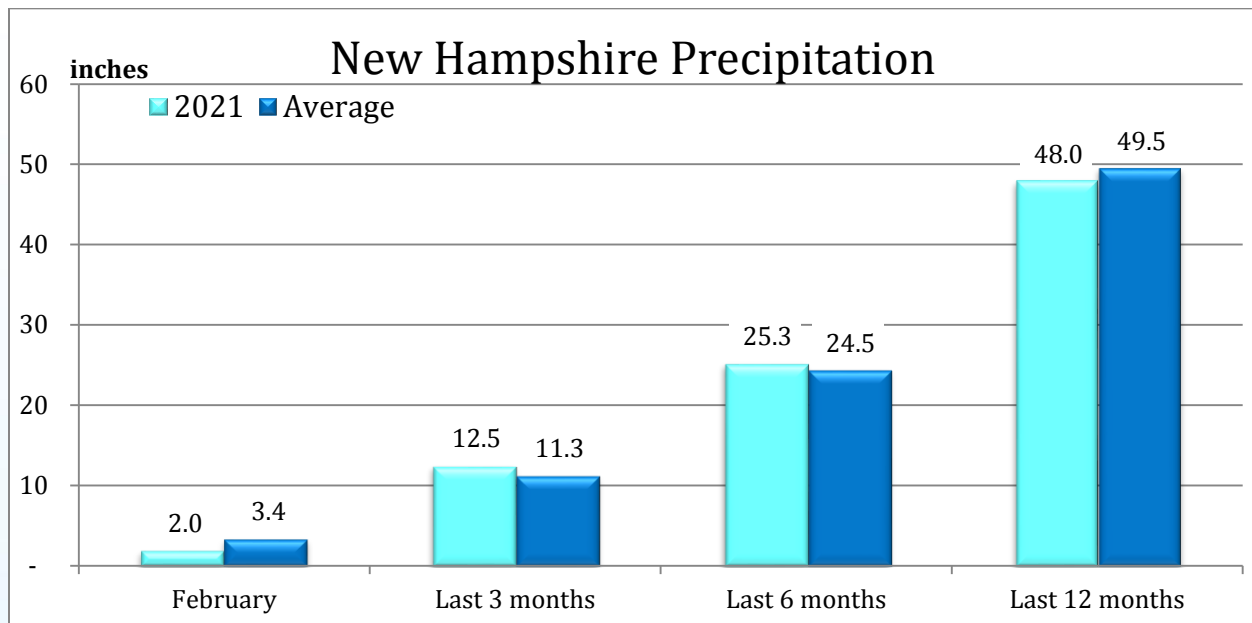

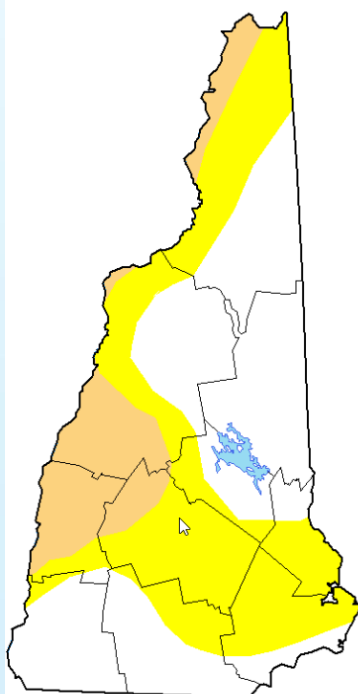
Weather Trends/Outlook

Seacoast drought conditions are static as only 2.0 inches of rainfall fell in February; compared to the average of 3.4 inches.



Current Water Use Restrictions

The U.S. Drought Monitor (<https://droughtmonitor.unl.edu>) currently shows that drought conditions continue to be **Abnormally Dry** on the New Hampshire seacoast. Currently, there are no water use restrictions.
