- Planting trees at Newtown High School to offset its paper usage.

It's Sprinkler Spruce-Up Time

Home and garden irrigation systems are great at delivering water, but they can also waste large amounts of it unless they're regularly inspected, adjusted and maintained. The EPA has found that homes with clock-timed systems use about 50 percent more water than other homes. Incorrect programming, improperly aimed heads, leaky pipes and other problems needlessly drain water supplies with no benefit to your lawns and gardens.

The EPA's WaterSense program has a

Reminder To Flush Water Systems

As our state prepares to reopen, buildings that have been closed for extended periods will begin to be reoccupied. Please remember to flush building water systems prior to returning to normal tap water



use. After an extended period of non-use, potable water can become stagnant. By flushing these systems, fresh water is drawn into the building from Aquarion's distribution system. To learn more about return to service flushing guidelines visit www.aquarionwater.com/flushing.
